On March 23, 2020 the Grant contract of the project was signed between the Ministry of Public Works, Development and Administration of Romania and Youth Public Organization “New European Generation” (Ukraine) as the Lead Beneficiary.



The project's overall objective is to improve the quality and access to entrepreneurial education through the development and implementation of 1 innovative program for training entrepreneurial skills, in order to support development of at least 75 business plans, by the end of project implementation, with the purpose of creating new businesses and jobs in the near future.

The main activities of the project are the following:

- Conduction of the launching and final conferences;
- Development of project's logo and web-site;
- Production and dissemination of visibility materials within the project;
- Conduction of study visits in Ukraine and Romania;
- Conduction of informing events in Ukraine and Romania;
- Purchase and implementation of CREDA system by the Lead Beneficiary - Youth Public Organization “New European Generation” (Ukraine), Beneficiary 1 - Izmil State University of Humanities (Ukraine) and Beneficiary 3 - Patronage of Small and Medium Sized Enterprises of Tulcea County (Romania) in Ukraine and Romania accordingly;
- Involvement of stakeholders selected after the information seminars for participation in trainings courses in entrepreneurial skills development in Tulcea, Romania;
- Rehabilitation and endowment of “Entrepreneurial Information Center” implemented by Beneficiary 2 - Tulcea County Agency for Employment (Romania).
